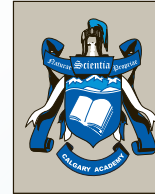

ABOUT CALGARY ACADEMY

Calgary Academy is an accredited private school for exceptional learners. The school was founded in 1981 by a group of parents and educators who were alarmed that students who were intellectually capable and motivated to learn were failing in community schools.

Since opening, Calgary Academy has educated more than 4,000 students from across Alberta and is now recognized as a leader in specialized academic programming. Over 98% of Calgary Academy students graduate with a high school diploma and more than 90% pursue post-secondary education within a year of graduation.

Today, Calgary Academy employs over 120 educational professionals and provides programs to over 625 students.

LOCATION & FACILITIES

Calgary Academy is situated four kilometers west of Sarcee Trail on 17 acres, overlooking the beautiful Rocky Mountains. In addition to classrooms, the school has 2 gymnasiums, a fitness center for use by staff and students, 4 digital science labs, a multimedia center, a second language lab, an art studio, drama theatre, a 120 seat presentation theatre, music centre, cafeteria, and extensive outdoor sports facilities.

Each of our technology rich classrooms has a ceiling mounted video projection unit, Smart Board, digital camera, printer and access to wireless Internet service.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Calgary Academy provides specialized educational programs for a spectrum of intellectually capable students who learn differently. While Calgary Academy was initially established to teach students with learning difficulties, we now offer two distinct programs. Students applying for either program must have a good social and behavioral history.

- Calgary Academy's Comprehensive Program, offered from Grades 2 through 12, is for students who have accumulated academic deficits. Students in the Comprehensive Program require extensive individual and small group remedial instruction. In each comprehensive classroom there are a minimum of two instructors and a maximum of 16 students.
- Calgary Academy's Transition Program, offered from Grades 5 through 12, is for students at or above grade level academically who require further development of the skills necessary for becoming independent as a learner. The Transition Program is offered to students who can learn in a whole group instructional setting with a student to teacher ratio of 16:1.

For many students entering Calgary Academy, school is synonymous with frustration and failure. At Calgary Academy, our entire faculty is committed to a school culture that provides every student with the range of supports necessary to succeed academically and socially, while enjoying their learning experience.

TEACHER COMPENSATION

- Calgary Academy teacher salaries are above provincial averages. Teachers new to the profession can expect to earn a salary between \$44,800 and \$50,500 per year, while experienced teachers can expect to earn up to \$84,000. The salary ranges reflect differing amounts of post-secondary education and teaching experience.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Calgary Academy recognizes that children who learn differently require an individualized instructional approach. We provide teachers new to the school with extensive training in meeting our students needs.

NON-WAGE BENEFITS

- Calgary Academy provides employees with generous medical and dental benefits, a group RRSP plan and funding for further education.
- Teachers new to Calgary Academy are provided with a comprehensive paid orientation and a strong personal mentor.
- Calgary Academy teachers receive personal laptops, extensive software and the training required to take advantage of the school's extensive technology.
- Calgary Academy classroom professionals are further supported by our onsite speech/language pathologists, psychologists, student counselors, reading specialists, and learning strategists. Moreover, each division has an Academic Director to provide support and help with programming for more complex students.
